We believe each child is a gift of God and deserves every opportunity to develop spiritually, emotionally, physically, intellectually and socially.

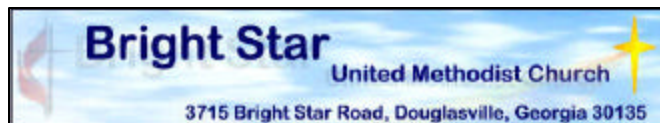
Mission:

Christian Based Curriculum

Bright Star Preschool uses a Christian preschool curriculum which emphasizes the whole child. Our teachers provide hands-on, quality experiences that guide children's learning in a nurturing environment.

A typical day may include art, music, science, math, circle time, story time, outdoor/gross motor play, small group or one-on-one interaction, snack and activity centers.

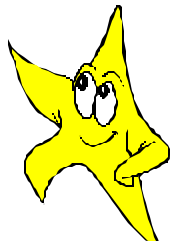
Physical development—gross motor: gaining strength & coordination, balance, music/movement; fine motor: using manipulatives & writing/drawing tools, developing small hand muscles.

Social/Emotional development—pro-social behavior, communication & the ability to express self, following directions, focus for a sustained period of time, independence & self-control, trust in self and others.

Intellectual development—problem solving, classifying & comparing objects, patterns, numbers & counting, dramatic play, K-readiness (4 year olds).

Language development—listening & speaking, reading & writing.

Spiritual development—bi-weekly Chapel with our BSUMC pastors, age appropriate Bible stories with accompanying scripture, modeling behavior promoting love, faith, trust, self-esteem, kindness, honesty, cooperation & appreciation.

Parents Morning Out-

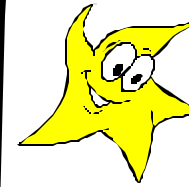
6 weeks —24 months, Children must be 6 weeks old by September 1 of the school year.

2 Year old Classes- - Must turn 2 by Sept. 1

3 & 4 Year Old Classes—Must turn 3 or 4 by Sept. 1

Registration

Pre-registration for the 2009-2010 school year will be held in Feb. & March A non-refundable registration fee of \$50 is due at the time of registration.



Tuition Options-

Tuition is payable Annually (A), Semi-annually (SA), or Monthly (M)

1-day a week: A=\$500, SA=\$250, M=\$50, Activity Fee: \$25 annually

2-days a week: A=\$1000, SA=\$500, M=\$100, Activity Fee:\$35 annually

3-days a week: A=\$1250, SA=\$625, M=\$125, Activity Fee: \$45 annually

5-days a week: A=\$1500, SA=\$750, M=\$150, Activity Fee: \$55 annually

Calendar
